Since we announced the proposed (and relocated) WestWing Recycling and Transfer Facility earlier this week, several individuals have reached out to us with ideas on how to improve the facility for the community, and we listened. Because of this input, we are offering two additional benefits to neighbors – (1) **free bulk waste drop-off once per month for local residents**; and (2) **installation of downward-facing lighting on the future facility to avoid light pollution**.

We felt both of these ideas were constructive. They are reasonable, and not only benefit the community, but also help us be a better operator and neighbor, something we strive for every day. Further, these enhancements will surely not be the last changes or enhancements as a result of public feedback for the site, located next to the WestWing power station in a zoned industrial park.
